

best to wreak havoc, she did not manage to stop production on SON's very first TV pilot! Work began in earnest on October 1, the cameras turned on October 22 and production wrapped on October 30. It was a hurricane of its own making!

SON is very pleased to have put Floridians to work with this project. The emphasis on "Florida First" continued throughout both the International Design Sources, and Arsenault crew hiring process and casting.

Of the 15 cast members, 13 were Floridians! And, of the 36 crew members, 23 were Floridians! The production spent roughly \$213,000 (49.42% of its total production budget) in Naples. An additional \$74,000 (17.17%) was spent in other areas of Florida.




WHAT'S IT ABOUT?
